

# Privacy Policy

## 1. Who we are

Destinus Group B.V. ("Destinus", "we", "us" or "our") is the controller of your personal data. We are a private European aerospace and defence company registered in the Netherlands.

## 2. What this policy covers

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, share and protect personal data when you visit our website at [www.destinus.com](http://www.destinus.com) (the "Website"). It applies to all visitors and users of the Website, regardless of location.

We do not operate user accounts or login functionality on the Website.

This policy should be read together with our [Cookie Policy](#).

## 3. What personal data we collect

We collect personal data in the following ways:

**Data you provide directly.** When you fill in a contact form, request information, or subscribe to our newsletter, you voluntarily provide us with information such as your name, email address, telephone number, company name, job title, and the content of your message.

**Data collected automatically.** When you visit the Website, certain information is collected automatically through cookies and similar technologies. This includes your IP address, browser type and version, operating system, referring URL, pages visited, time spent on pages, and general geographic location (city/country level). For full details, see our [Cookie Policy](#).

**Data from third-party embeds.** Our Website may embed content from third parties, including YouTube videos, LinkedIn widgets, and Google Calendar widgets. These services may collect data about you through their own cookies and tracking technologies when you

interact with the embedded content. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of these third parties.

## 4. Why we process your data and on what legal basis

We process your personal data only when we have a valid legal basis under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The table below sets out the purposes of processing, the categories of data involved, and the legal basis we rely on.

Responding to your enquiries submitted through contact forms	Name, email, phone number, company, job title, message content	Art. 6(1)(b) — necessary for taking steps at your request prior to entering into a contract; or Art. 6(1)(f) — our legitimate interest in communicating with prospective partners and clients
Sending newsletters and marketing communications	Name, email address	Art. 6(1)(a) — your consent, which you can withdraw at any time
Analysing website traffic and improving our Website	IP address (anonymised), browser data, pages visited, session data	Art. 6(1)(f) — our legitimate interest in understanding how visitors use our Website and improving its performance
Ensuring website security and preventing abuse	IP address, access logs, technical data	Art. 6(1)(f) — our legitimate interest in keeping our Website secure
Displaying embedded third-party content (YouTube, LinkedIn, Google Calendar)	Data collected by the respective third party	Art. 6(1)(a) — your consent given through our cookie consent mechanism

Where we rely on legitimate interest, we have carried out a balancing test to ensure that our interests do not override your fundamental rights and freedoms. You may object to processing based on legitimate interest at any time (see Section 9).

## 5. Who we share your data with

We do not sell your personal data. We share it only with the following categories of recipients, and only to the extent necessary:

**Service providers.** We use the following third-party service providers who process data on our behalf under data processing agreements:

- **Webflow, Inc.** — website hosting and content management. Webflow may process certain technical data (e.g. IP addresses, browser information) in connection with delivering and securing the Website. Webflow's servers are located in the United States. [See Webflow's privacy policy.](#)
- **Google LLC (Google Analytics 4)** — website analytics. We use GA4 in analytics-only mode (advertising features and Google Signals are disabled). IP addresses are

anonymised before processing. Google may process data on servers in the United States. [See Google's privacy policy.](#)

**Third-party embeds.** When you interact with embedded YouTube videos, LinkedIn widgets, or Google Calendar widgets, the respective provider may collect data directly from your browser. These providers act as independent controllers:

**Other disclosures.** We may disclose your personal data if required by law, regulation, legal process, or enforceable governmental request, or to protect our rights, safety, or property.

## 6. International data transfers

Some of our service providers (Webflow, Google, LinkedIn, YouTube) are based in or operate from the United States. When personal data is transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA), we ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place, including:

- The European Commission's adequacy decisions, where applicable.
- Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) approved by the European Commission.
- Any additional supplementary measures required by applicable guidance from the European Data Protection Board (EDPB).

## 7. How long we keep your data

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes described in this policy, or as required by law. The retention periods are:

Contact form submissions	12 months after your last interaction, unless a business relationship is established
Newsletter subscriber data	Until you unsubscribe, plus 5 working days for processing
Website analytics data (GA4)	14 months (as configured in Google Analytics)
Server and access logs	90 days

After the retention period expires, we securely delete or anonymise the data.

## 8. How we protect your data

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data against unauthorised access, loss, alteration, or destruction. These measures include

encryption of data in transit (TLS/SSL), access controls, and regular reviews of our security practices.

No method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your data, we cannot guarantee absolute security.

## 9. Your rights

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

**Right of access** — You may request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.

**Right to rectification** — You may ask us to correct inaccurate or incomplete data.

**Right to erasure** — You may request that we delete your data where there is no compelling reason for us to continue processing it.

**Right to restrict processing** — You may ask us to temporarily halt the processing of your data in certain circumstances.

**Right to data portability** — You may request to receive your data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format.

**Right to object** — You may object to processing based on legitimate interest or direct marketing at any time.

**Right to withdraw consent** — Where processing is based on consent, you may withdraw it at any time. Withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal.

**Right not to be subject to automated decision-making** — We do not use automated decision-making or profiling that produces legal effects concerning you.

We will not charge a fee for handling your request unless it is manifestly unfounded or excessive.

We will not send you marketing communications unless you have given your explicit consent. We do not share your email address with third parties for their own marketing purposes.

## **11. Third-party links**

## **12. Children's privacy**

Our Website is not directed at individuals under the age of 16. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children. If we become aware that we have inadvertently collected data from a child, we will take steps to delete it promptly.

## **13. Changes to this policy**

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices or applicable law. When we make changes, we will update the "Last updated" date at the top of this page. For material changes, we will provide a prominent notice on our Website.

## **14. Complaints**

If you believe that we have not handled your personal data in accordance with applicable law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
